

## **Class of 2009 Senior All Night Party (SANP) Committee October 7, 2008**

Dave Luce gave an update on can drive. \$2900 has been collected for the SANP for the months of June through September.

Terry Brasch gave update on pumpkin sales. \$180 was raised for SANP.

Spaghetti feed details:

- November 21 from 6:00-8:30 p.m. at the High School
- Cost - \$8.00/plate or \$30.00 for family (maximum of 6 people)
- Dinner will include spaghetti, salad, bread, dessert and soda
- A raffle or 50/50 will be held during the dinner
- Spaghetti, sauce, meat and soda will be donated by Chrissy Rouches & family.
- Coffee cart will be made available so people can purchase coffee
- Tickets will not be pre-sold nor will we ask for RSVPs
- It was decided that Bingo will be a separate event and will not occur with the spaghetti dinner.

Needs:

- Confirm that kitchen equipment will be available for use (Allison to check with Gail)
- Need one kitchen staff person at the event
- Need volunteers to cook, serve food, run coffee cart, and sell raffle tickets
- Donations for salad, desserts, parmesan cheese, bottled water and bread
  - Jacki will check with Winco Bakery on bread as well as seeking a monetary donation (gift card);
  - Mellony will seek donations from Costco and Orowheat Bakery
- Advertising
  - Syndee will draft up flyer and share with committee. Once approved flyer will be sent to Lisa Jones for posting on e-mail list serve.
  - Jacki will draft letter to senior parents and will contact Lisa Jones to ask that senior class mailing labels be printed. Volunteers will be needed to go to the school to label and stuff envelopes
  - Need copies of flyer made for the mailing as well as to distribute at homecoming
  - Allison to contact mid-county memo to have information posted in the November issue
  - DJ will post on craigslist
  - It was suggested that the school send a recording to all parents for the event

### Other fundraising

- Dave Kuhn presented information on glow sticks and glow necklaces to sell at the homecoming game. 800 items would cost \$270 including shipping.
  - Color = Green
  - Will last 8 hours
  - Need some assembly (connector/string)
- Agreed to purchase and will sell glow sticks/necklaces for \$1.00 each (or \$2) at the homecoming game and dance. Any left over items can be sold at future events (other sporting events, dances, etc)
- Will need volunteers to sell at game and dance

### Spirit Mountain Casino

- Allison shared information on getting a bus (free of charge from Casino) and charging adults a set amount to ride the bus to and from the casino. Alcohol and food can be included on the trip. Allison and Mellony to get more details.

### Portland Roasters

- Allison indicated that the Middle School is conducting a fundraiser where order forms are distributed to teachers and families to purchase coffee at \$10/pound. Coffee is delivered to the school and then distributed. Jacki will look into further.

Terry shared that we need to start thinking about designing a T-Shirt and coming up with a theme. Concerns were expressed because T-shirts were not printed in timely manner. Allison will check with Twisted Stitches to see what may have happened and how to get shirts printed on time.

Terry will develop a flyer to give to all Seniors asking for their input on a theme for the SANP as well as a check box to see how many seniors plan to attend.
